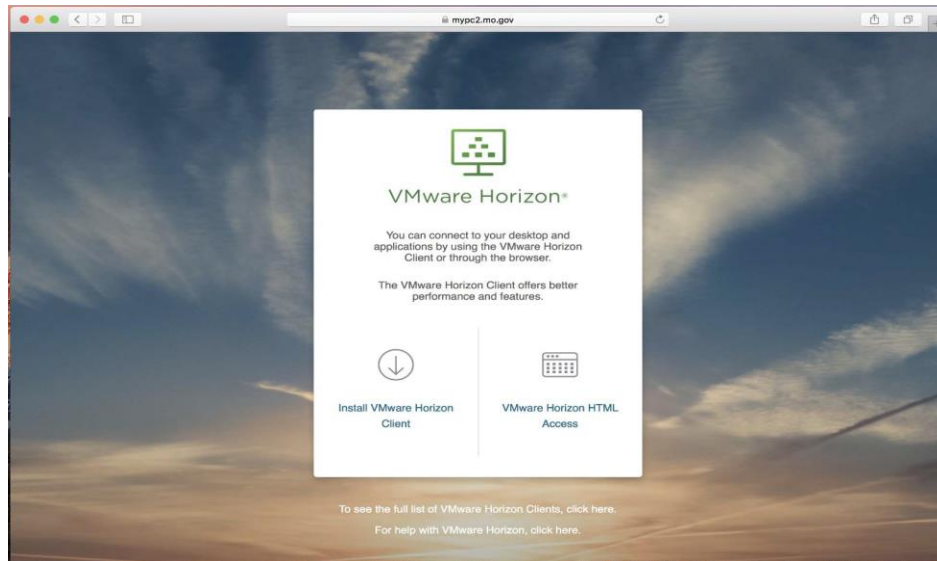
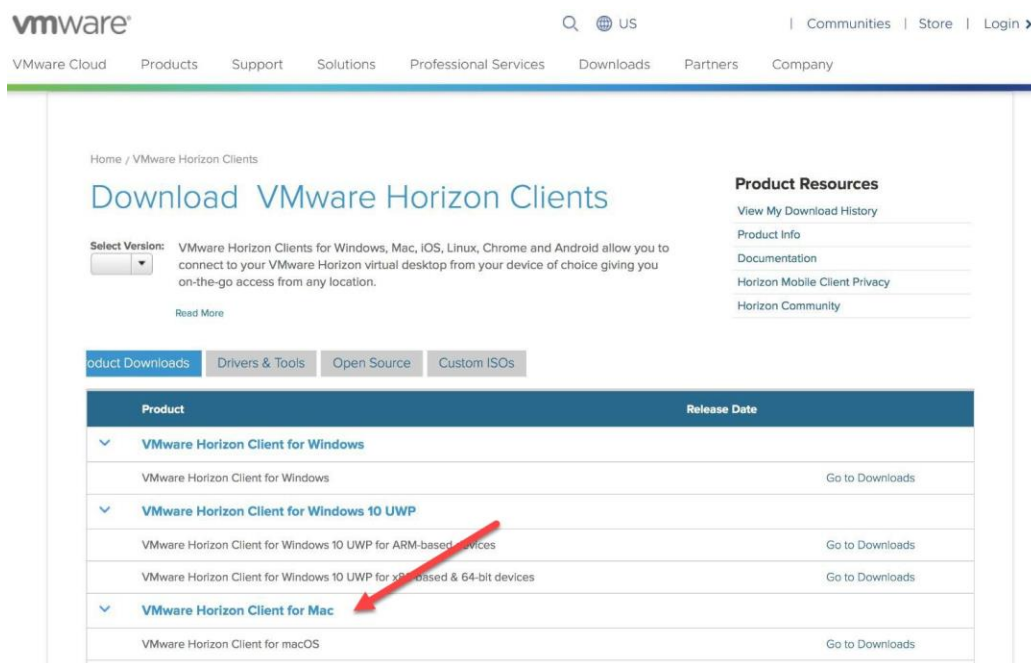


Connecting to a Virtual Desktop on VMware Horizon Client with a Mac

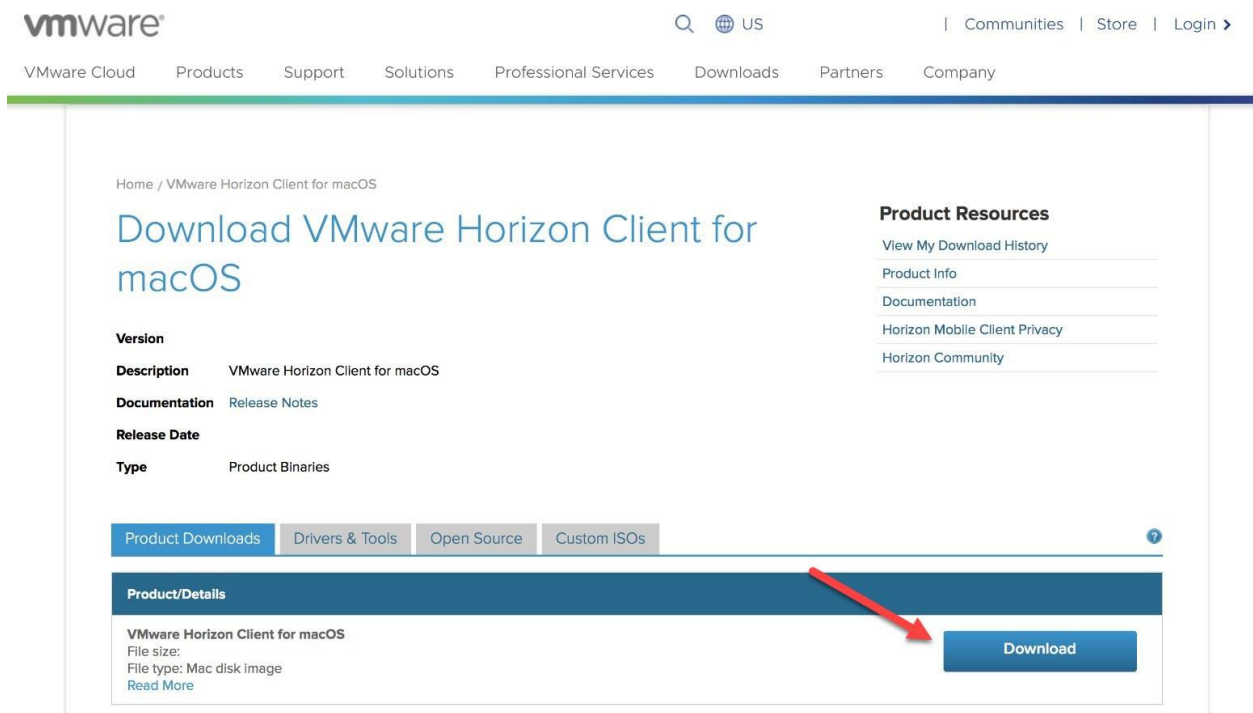
1. Open **Safari** and go to <https://myvc2.mo.gov/> . Then click on **Install VMware Horizon Client**.



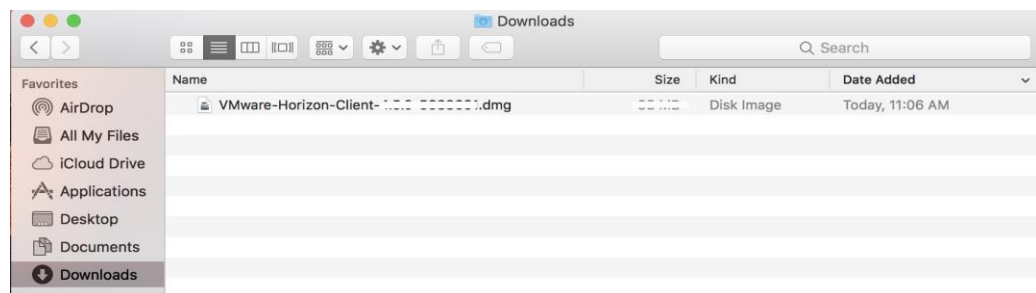
2. Scroll to find the section for **VMware Horizon Client for Mac** and select **Go to Downloads**.



3. You will be taken to the latest version of the VMware Horizon Client for Mac where you will select **Download**.



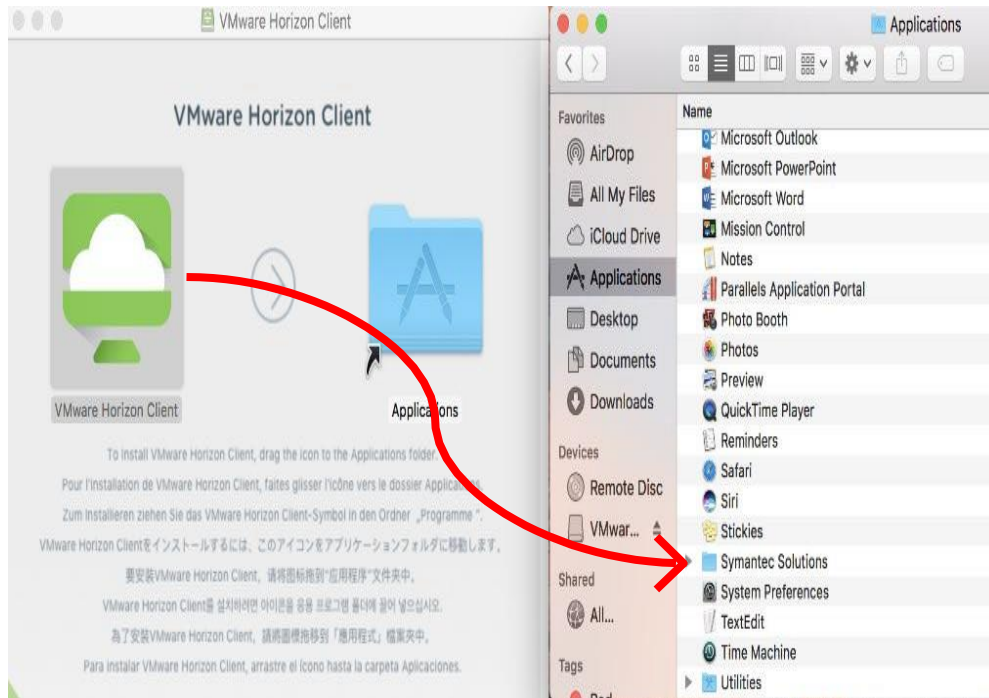
4. **Open Finder** and **navigate to the Downloads** folder. You should see a file named **VMware-Horizon-Client**. You will want to **open** this file.



5. If you would like to proceed you will select **Agree**. It will open the file and should end with the opening of a VMware Horizon Client window.

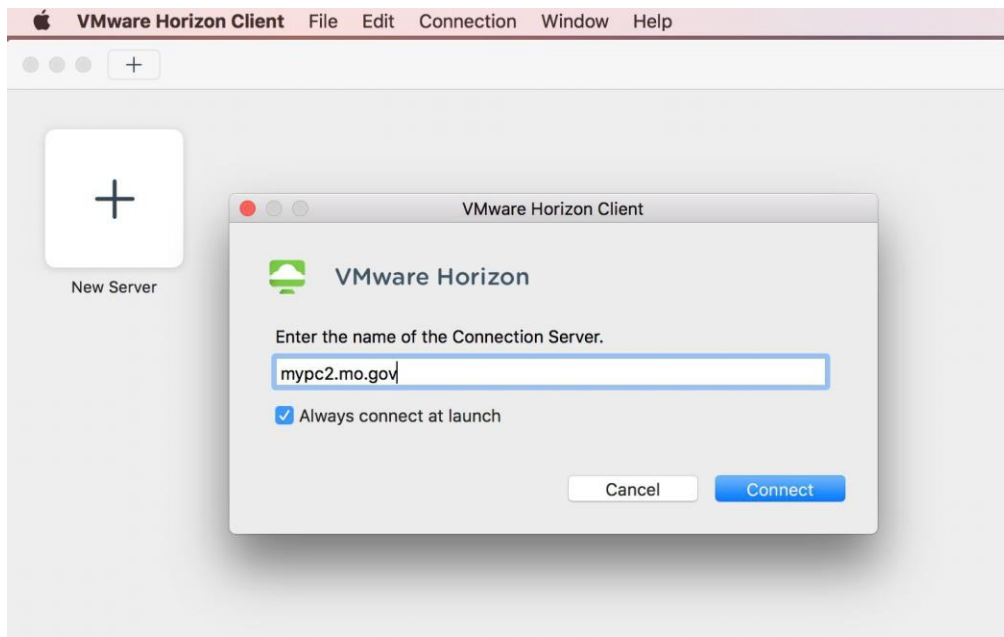


6. ***To install***, switch back to the **Finder** and select **Applications** under **Favorites**. **Click and drag** the VMware View Client icon to the Applications window.

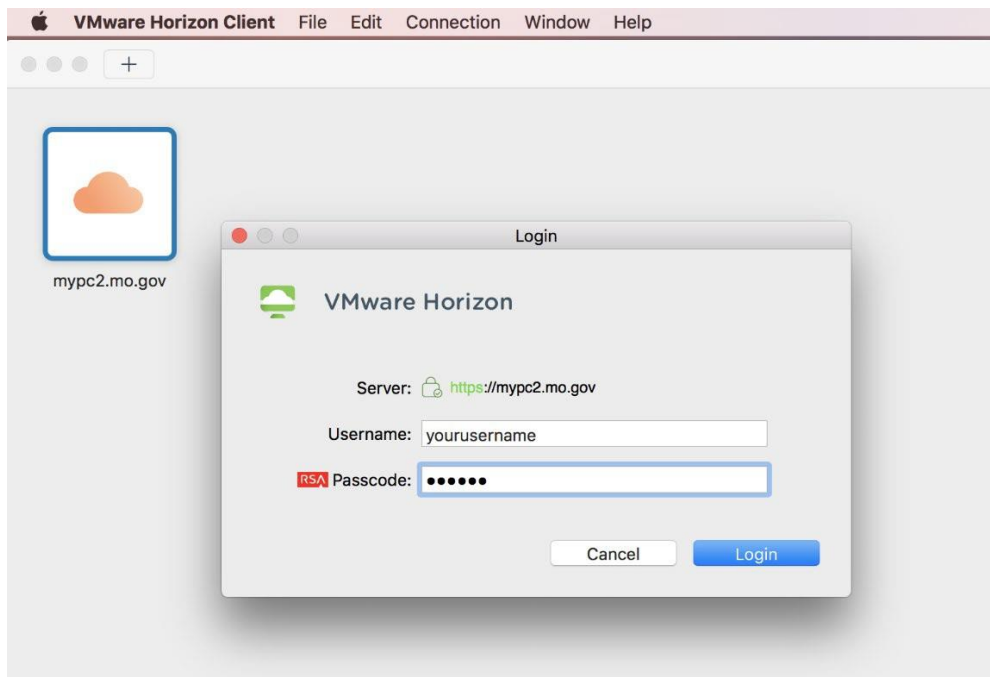


7. You are ready to open the VMware View Client from the Applications window. Upon opening the VMware View Client you may receive a warning window asking if you are sure you want to open it. If you are sure, you should **select Open**. **After clicking Open you may receive a window asking to “Start Remote USB and Printing Services”.** **Click Cancel.**

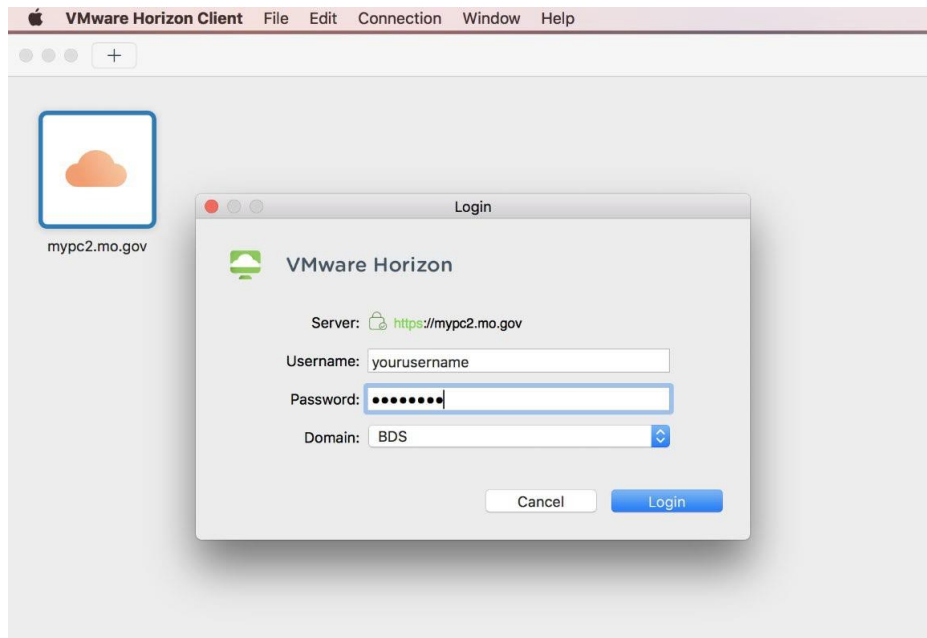
8. The VMware View Client will open and you will be prompted to add a server. **Click the New Server icon** in the middle of the window and **enter the host name as shown below** and select **Connect**:



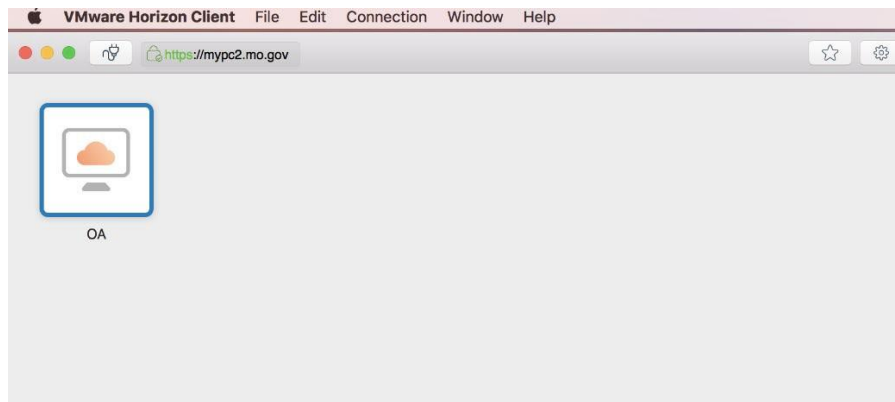
9. *If you're connecting outside of the State of Missouri network, you'll be prompted for your **network username and RSA Passcode**. Enter those and click Login. (If you're connecting internally **proceed to step 10**)*



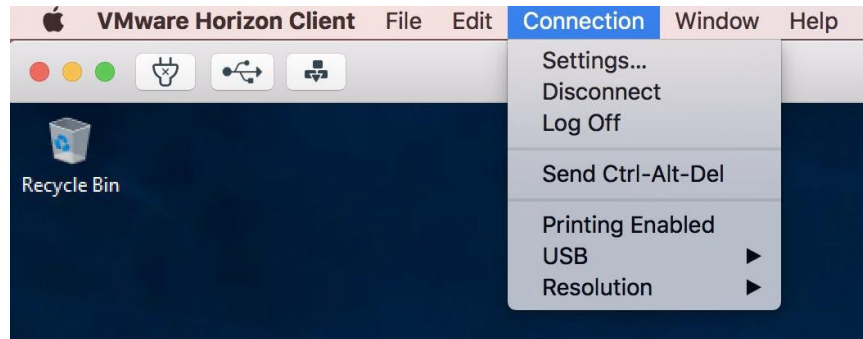
- Please refer to your RSA SecurID app installed on your device. The numbers change every 60 seconds. The numbers in your RSA SecurID app will be entered in the passcode field above. **
10. You will then **enter your network username, password** and ensure the correct **domain is selected** and click **Continue**. (Note: this is the same username, password and domain that you use when you are in the office)



11. You will then receive a window similar to the one below. **To connect, you must double-click the monitor.**



12. When you are done using the virtual desktop, **go to Connection** and **choose either Disconnect** (if you want to leave the existing programs running on the VDI) **or** you can **go to the start button in Windows and choose Restart** (if you are done with everything).
